Griefs – (Strong's #2483, "Choli" – Khol – ee') - sickness, grief, calamity, anxiety, disease

Sorrows – (Strong's #4341, "makob" – mak – obe') – anguish, affliction, pain, sorrow, physical pain, mental pain

"That it might be fulfilled with was spoken by the prophet Isaiah, saying, "Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses." (Matt. 8:17)

Infirmities – (Strong's #769, "Asthenia" – As-then'-i-ah) – feebleness (of body or mind), by implication malady, moral frailty, disease, infirmity, sickness, weakness

Sicknesses – (Strong's #3554, "Nosos," – Nos' – sos) – A terminal condition for which there is no natural cure; a sickness that was the result of evil spirits; a condition for which there was no known cure

"And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people."
(Matt. 4:23)

Sickness – (Nosos) – see previous notes – Cancer, Aids, Covid-19, etc.

Disease – (Strong's #3119 – "Malakia" – Mal – ak – ee' – ah) – debility, a crippling or debilitating sickness (You can live with it, but can't function.)

Healing – (Strong's #2323, "Therapeuo" – ther – ap – yoo' – o) – To relieve, cure, therapy; a healing that requires corresponding actions.

Of the ministry of Jesus, according to some historians, out of the three and a half years that He ministered in the earth, there are only 53 days of documented miracles in the four gospels...And many of the them occurred on the same day. (365 days of the year!)

Healed – (Strong's #2390, "laomai" – (ee - ah'-om – ahee) – to cure, to be doctored; a healing power that progressively reverses a condition; a progressive, restorative healing power. (Matt. 8:13; Mark 5:29; Luke 7:7)

"And His fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto Him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils, and those which were lunatic, and those that had the palsy; and He healed them. (Matt. 4:24)

"And at even, when the sun did set, they brought (Pherō) unto Him all that were diseased, and them that were possessed with devils." (Mark 1:32) ff.

Diseased – (Strong's #2560, "Kakos," – Kak – oce') – Badly (physically or morally) miserably sick and afflicted; extremely sick; in the last stages of their condition; a terminal case

Jesus, Jehoshua, Yeshua

Yasha – (Hebrew) - means rescue, help, defend, preserve, make free, attain victory, to bring to safety, heal, save

All people spend their lives searching for it!

Yasha → Yeshua → Salvation

"Behold, God is my Salvation, I will trust and not be afraid; for Yah (Jehovah) is my strength and song; He also has become my Salvation." (Isa. 12:2) (Exod. 15:2) "Yeshua"

"And she will bring forth a son, and you shall call His name Yeshua, for He shall save His people from their sins." (Matt. 1:21)

*"The name of the Lord is a strong tower; the righteous man runs into it. (Prov. 18:10) **Yeshua!***

The greatest blessing God has given to man is the blessing of Salvation!

Blessed – (Strong’s #2127, “Eulogeo,” – yoo – log – eh’ – o) – To speak well of, to bless, to thank or invoke a benediction upon, prosper

As we meditate on God’s Word and spend time with Him, we should ask Him to reveal to us what He has spoken over us – the blessings in His heart that are bestowed on us and to us...

Then, our correct response to what He has said should be... AMEN!

Hebrew “Blessed” – (Strong’s #1288, “Barak” – Baw – rak) – to kneel as an act of adoration

Thus, for God to **bless** us with “Salvation,” He had to kneel – lower or humble Himself!

The greatest blessing required the greatest lowering of Himself: the greatest descension!

He humbled Himself – See Philippians 2:5-11

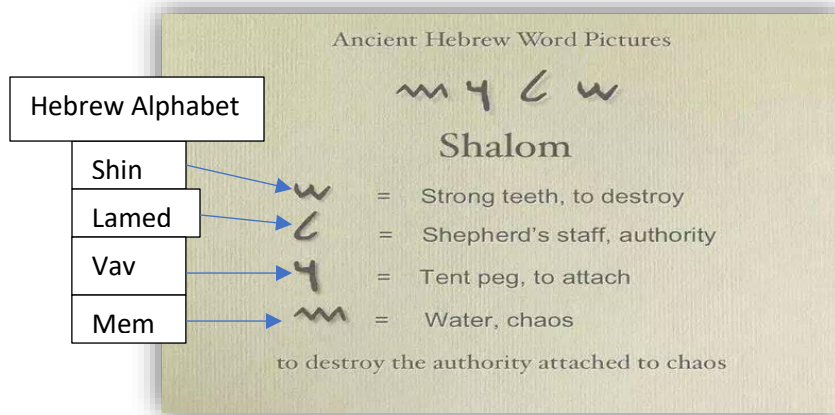
He had to submit to:
